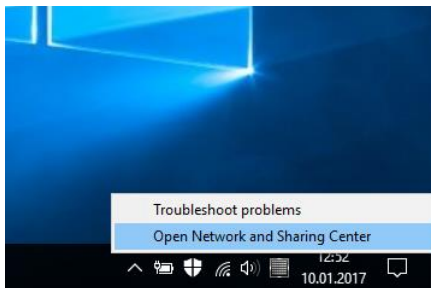


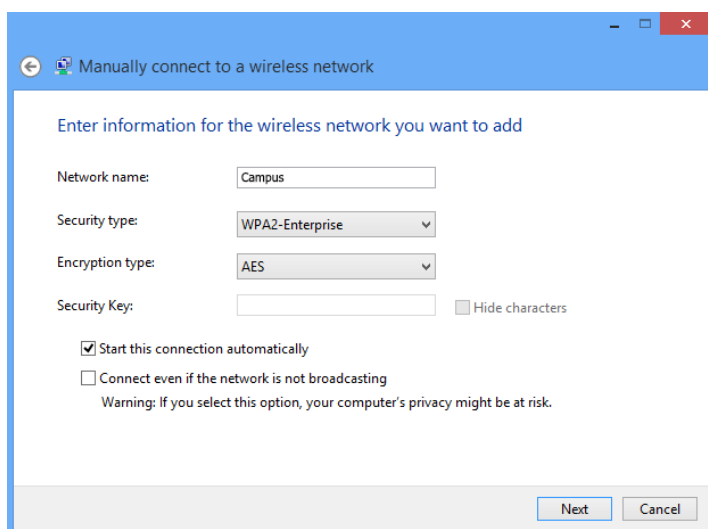
Wireless Network Connection Instruction

Microsoft Windows 8

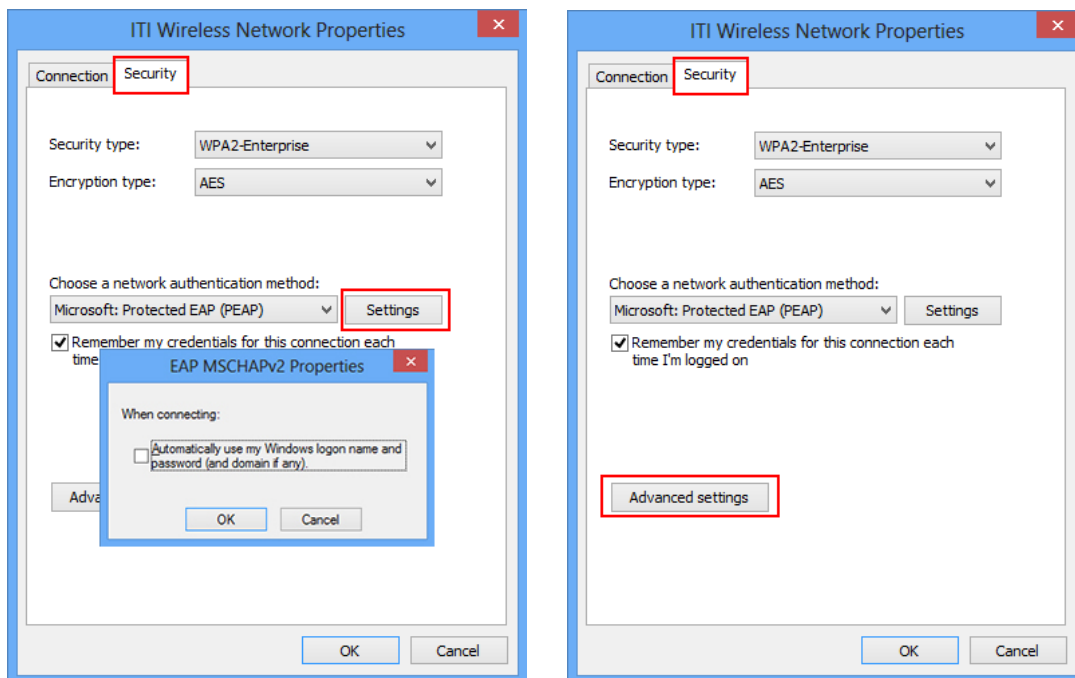
1. Go to your Desktop
2. Right Click on the Wireless Icon in the notification area and click “Open Network and Sharing Center”



3. From the main window select “Setup a new connection or network”
4. Then select “Manually connect to a wireless network” and then click “Next”
5. Into “Network name” type Campus
6. Set the “Security type” to “WPA2- Enterprise”
Set the “Encryption type” to “EAS”
7. Check the “Start this connection automatically” checkbox
8. Check the “Connect even if the network is not broadcasting” checkbox
9. Click on “Next”

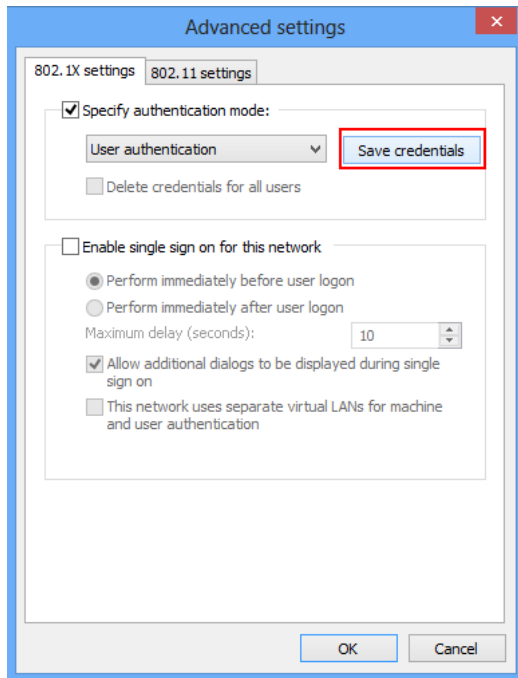


10. Click on “Change connection settings” in the next window and Click the “Security” tab
11. Ensure that “Choose a network authentication method:” is set to “Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)”
12. Click on “Settings”
13. Untick “Validate server certificate” checkbox.
14. Click on “Configure” button
15. Untick “Automatically use my Windows logon...”
16. Click on “OK” twice



17. Click on “Advanced Settings” in the security tab window you should now be in

18. Click on “Specify authentication mode”
19. Select the “User authentication” option from the menu
20. Click on “Save credentials”



21. Enter your Humanitas University account
 - a. Type **Humanitas\your username** into the **Username** field
 - b. **Your password** into the **Pasword** field
22. Click on “Ok”
23. Click on “Close”
24. Now you are connected to campus net
